· Opening Prayer -

1. Masks, social distancing, and getting together

- Conditions of masks in building – any changes to be made to policy so far?
 - **Kansas City's mask mandate is set to expire Sept. 23. City council this week could extend it to Oct. 7.**
 - **Masks are recommended inside, when you cannot maintain 6 feet distance. But we're limited in enforcement.**
 - Specifically addressing mask fatigue – continue to monitor and review at the next meeting.
- Aug. 13 press release - "All employees or visitors to any place of public accommodation must continue to wear face coverings in an area or while performing an activity which will necessarily involve close contact or proximity to co-workers or the public where six feet of separation is not feasible. Taverns and bars continue to operate at a 50 percent maximum capacity."

2. Staffing and how the office is doing with the COVID.

- Best information is that everyone has tested negative recently, everybody is back to regular work schedule. No bad news from volunteers.
- When should an infected person come back to work?
 - Short answer is when the doctor clears them to come back.
 - In the FAQ, when a member or staff tests positive, quarantine 14 days, and then have a negative test, and be symptom free within 72 hours of returning, as well as notify anyone who came into contact with them.
