We are excited to announce that our special Christmas Eve Offering will be going to Northwest Haiti Christian Mission and Greg and Elizabeth Mook! Northwest Haiti Christian Mission is a faithful partner in the North West (NW) state of Haiti. Bringing a Christian witness and various life-giving ministries is a real struggle in the poorest western country amidst political and civil strife. Most mission visits have been suspended due to safety issues. Even so, a brand-new birthing center is helping mothers deliver safely every day. Greg and Elizabeth Mook are EPC missionaries in Beirut, Lebanon. Their goal as missionaries is to plant a church that ministers to an unreached people group. So they are working to cultivate a reproducing church of Syrian refugees in Lebanon through evangelism and discipleship. Recently, the Mook's ministry team had to be evacuated for about 2 months at the start of the war to the south of them. They recently all returned just in time for the Christmas season and are glad to be back. The Mook family is eager to get back to Arabic language learning, a Bible study with a family of fairly new believers, helping with the youth ministry at their local church, and visiting people in their homes to pray with them and share about Jesus. Pray for all these things and for their stress levels being so close to conflict.

Gashland EPC is thrilled to partner with these two ministries and live out the great commission through them! 
