III. Old Business

Mark will set up a meeting for discussion. This group also needs to reach out to the shut-ins or those that can't get out much.
- 3. Website Continued discussion from previous meeting about small improvements that can be made to Gashland website and sign in front of church. Michael agreed that this should be done and also include better calendar for upcoming events so that new people can find out how to get plugged in. This will be brought up at Session so we can figure out who this should be assigned to.

4. Corn Hole event planned for March 2nd 6:30-8:30. Ministry Center has been reserved from 6-9. There will be events for all ages, but no nursery provided that evening. We will provide popcorn and drinks and ask people to bring a snack to share.

IV. Reports -

- A. Abide Michael trained 5 new teachers for Abide. The coffee bar has been moved against the wall and traffic pattern is working well. Abide will combine their Feb event with the Corn Hole event.
- B. The Women's ministry Lyn Vande Polder attended and gave a report. Apples of Gold is currently going on a way for women to encourage and be encouraged by other women. Day of Prayer will be decided at the Women's meeting on Thursday.
- C. The Men's ministry Chris Schupp attended and gave a report. Scripture reading will continue to be the last Sunday of the month. For now, this will stay with Men's Ministry and not be part of Discipleship. Campfire also continues monthly. Chris will be teaching men's Sunday School class on Fruits of the Spirit.
- D. Conversations Having meal and just fellowship time (no teaching) is not drawing a big crowd. Talked about having some scripture verses or ice breaker questions at each table. We will do a game night on February 28th. Session has asked to use February 21st night for Q/A on Pastor Search. This could have a higher attendance than normal, so plan meal accordingly. February 14th conversations will be potluck soup night. Ash Wednesday service will begin at 7:15 in the Ministry Center. There will be a link to sign up if you are bringing soup.

V. New Business

South Lobby Coffee Table. Discussed the vision of what the space in the south lobby should be and if a welcome/multi-use/coffee bar is needed. Chris Schupp agreed to come up with some plans on potential options. This would also involve Outreach and could potentially have people stationed there each week to answer questions, direct people, etc. We agreed that the Relationships team should own this. Need to determine what the vision/purpose is for that space. This could be part of the Capital Campaign, but will not happen until after the Children's Ministry carpet project is done.

Summer Picnic – We will combine our Summer kickoff picnic with Breakaway picnic on June 9^{th} after 2^{nd} service. Events will be outside. Mark suggested cooking hamburgers/hot dogs and having people bring sides and dessert. More discussion to follow.

Have an event, possibly in April/May, called "Chicken and Pickle" and have fried chicken from HyVee and a pickle ball tournament. Discuss at next meeting.
