Main Responsibilities:

- Plan and coordinate with the Pastor the weekly liturgy and hymns/songs for the Sunday Services
- Lead 1st and 2nd Service worship
- Shepherd people through the significance of the lyrics we sing and the liturgy we use on Sunday mornings
- Oversee Choir Director and Accompanist
- Oversee, coordinate and lead a volunteer team of musicians and audio/visual team

- Maintain current worship volunteers and regularly recruit new musicians, singers, and supporting volunteers as needed for both services.
- Invest, build community, and teamwork with worship volunteers
- Lead weekly rehearsals for worship
- Add traditional instrumentation to 1st service hymns and arrange according to volunteer skillsets
- Schedule volunteers needed for worship each Sunday including communion Sundays
- Prepares all necessary elements for volunteers on Sunday morning
- Purchase necessary music and supplies as budgeted by the Worship Team
- Prepare or oversee preparation of slides for 1st Service Livestream and 2nd Service Livestream and in-person.
- Oversee maintenance and purchasing of equipment and instruments in conjunction with the Worship Team
- Lead and help plan seasonal services (Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter) and other nights of worship
- Attend weekly staff meetings
- Attend monthly Worship Team meetings
- Comply with all church policies
- Other responsibilities as required or assigned by Senior Pastor or Session
