Tonight's Christmas Eve Offering

Each year, on Christmas Eve, we take a special offering which goes to help our missionaries. The Leadership of the church has decided that this year, our Christmas Eve offering will be shared by two of our missionaries. We will send funds to Robert Mulumbi and Greg & Elizabeth Mook.

Robert Mulumbi is ministering in Kenya. Robert has planted 7 churches in Kenya and is serving as Bishop over them. As Bishop he provides leadership, mentoring, shepherding, and accountability. Robert also oversees the International Bible Institute that trains people for ministry. They currently have 214 students. Robert oversees as well the Nancy George Primary Academy which has 450 children and 33 staff. Donations given tonight will be used to help Robert purchase a van that his church plants will use for their essential travel needs.

Greg and Elizabeth Mook are EPC missionaries in Beirut, Lebanon. Their goal as missionaries is to plant a church that ministers to an unreached people group. They are working to cultivate a reproducing church of Syrian refugees in Lebanon through evangelism and discipleship.

Gashland is thrilled to partner with these two ministries and live out the great commission through them! Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, Verse by Verse

Paul's letter to the Ephesians is a classic example of his thought alongside Romans. Ephesians is heavenly in content and expansive in the truths it proclaims while remaining approachable and pragmatic in its instructions. Here are three things we'll consider as we study Paul's letter to the Ephesians.

- 1. Ephesians is deliberately broad and general.
- 2. The Ephesian Christians were marginalized.
- 3. The church in Ephesus grew in the midst of spiritual warfare.

The dangers facing the Ephesian Christians were not just the threat of physical violence or social marginalization, but assault from spiritual forces of evil. Paul warns about "rulers," "authorities," and "cosmic powers" (Eph. 6:12)."
